Biography

When called to the Bar in early 2006, Bridie had already enjoyed success in an academic career in International Political Economy at the University of Sydney and the University of New South Wales.

Bridie was the associate to the Honourable Justice James L. B. Allsop, then a Justice of the Federal Court, subsequently the President of the Court of Appeal of New South Wales, and now the Chief Justice of the Federal Court of Australia.

Building the foundations of her career, Bridie began her legal journey as a barrister's research assistant and solicitor at Freehills (now Herbert Smith Freehills) practising in Litigation and Intellectual Property. She was subsequently a lecturer at the Faculty of Law, University of Sydney, lecturing in Litigation and Evidence and Administrative Law.

Receiving her undergraduate education at the University of Sydney, with a Bachelor of Arts (Honours), Bridie majored in Government and English. As a post-graduate, Bridie completed her Masters of International Studies, where she was awarded first class honours and graduated first in the year. Bridie also there researched, on scholarship, her Doctorate of Philosophy in Economics.
